

A tour of Medicinal Garden of Rammohan College

Department of Chemistry, Rammohan College organized a tour of Rammohan College's Medicinal Garden, situated at new science building for the Chemistry honours students of second semester, fourth semester and sixth semester, on 21st June, 2024 under the supervision of Dr. Moumita Mondal from the Department of Botany, Dr. Piu Dhal and Dr. Madhuparna Mukherjee of the Department of Chemistry.

The Medicinal Garden is maintained by the Department of Botany of Rammohan College which is our college's pride. Rammohan College also has two specially designed ponds, one round and another square for the study of "Food Chain Dynamics" in Aquatic Ecosystem. This garden is a natural repository of medicinal plants which signifies a rich heritage of traditional knowledge and plant diversity. A medicinal plant contains substances that can be used for therapeutic purposes.

This garden is endowed with various plants of medicinal importance like Berela, New Caledonian Pine, Tulsi, Lemongrass, Swarnachampa, Gritakumari, Atasi, Periwinkle, Moses in the cradle etc. The garden is a no-plastic zone. So, don't carry plastic bags.

It didn't take long for the students to connect with nature as soon as they entered the garden. It gave our students exposure to common and rare medicinal plant species with comprehensive knowledge of identification and research and also created an awareness of conservation and traditional uses of herbs and medicinal plants.
