

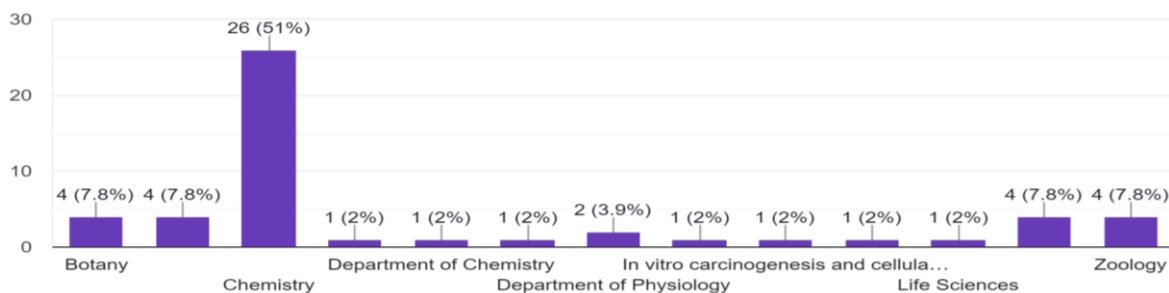
## FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

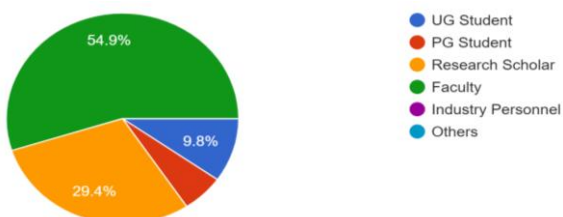
**Total Registered participants: 125**
