#### Article 1

- 2. Any changes of the location of the programme shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

#### Article 5


#### MODE OF CONDUCTING THE programme


The programme will be conducted primarily in the Offline mode. Ample arrangements should also be made to conduct programme in the online mode.

#### Article 6

#### **DURATION AND TERMINATION**

- 3) Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notification to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MOU, six (6) months prior to the date of the termination.
- 4) The termination of this MOU shall not affect the completion of any project's and programme's in progress and not completed at the time of termination,





#### Article 7

#### **AMENDMENT**

- 1) This MOU may be amended or revised at any time mutual written consent of the Parties and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
- 2) Such amendment's or revision's shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

#### Article 8

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultations or negotiations between the Parties.
